This fantasy adventure begins with a castle, and two brothers named Cory and Kyler. The two boys live with their mother, as their dad leaves on a military mission far out at sea.

While the two boys miss their Dad, their Mom home schools them, insisting they keep up their studies.

With simple rhyme and a relatable story, the boy's study, play with their toys, paint, play music and write. Like typical boys they wrestle, and have so much energy that they end up outside, where they climb rocks and swim in the stream.


