ABOUT MY WORK:

I'm originally from New Jersey and was raised in a boating family and had all kinds of pets. Both have greatly influenced my writing and art.

My first short story was published at the age of 14 in a national magazine "Popular Dogs". Since then, my work has branched out into writing stage and screenplays some of which have won awards: The Great Mudbug War, That's the Spirit: A Haunting Comedy, Riders of the North Wind, and The Swamp Dragon. During the same time, I also wrote and had traditionally published novels that include historical fictions: Silver Eagles, a Civil War novel about Ames, Chamberlain and the 20th Maine, The Swamp Dragon, a Civil War fantasy novel, Dark Waters, a maritime novel about the Lusitania disaster, a maritime historical Storm Warning, about the chase, capture, and trial of the only slaver ever hung for piracy, a political comedy, Ghost of a Chance. Most recent books include, The Cat Who Fell to Earth, a first contact science fiction, The 13th Child, a horror that is a different take on the Jersey Devil legend and Arizona Red Ghost, a Western novella based on a true story. All work is traditionally published by royalty publishers. All can be found on Barnes & Nobel, Amazon and from the publishers. Some of my short stories have appeared in anthologies in print and online.

I have done professional artwork since the age of 18. I work in the medias of oils, acrylics, pen and ink, colored pencil and graphite pencil. Subject matter runs from wildlife paintings and pet portraits to illustration and cartoons. I have won many awards and had work exhibited in galleries including the

Smithsonian. My last illustration work was children's book illustrations for Gini Graham Scott of Changemakers.

Presently I live in Fisher, WV. I teach in the local school district where students tell me I am their favorite teacher, and I am a naturalist in the summer at a state park. When teaching I can share my passions, especially if my students get their work done on time. Every moment is shared by my two creative passions. Pricing For Writing, Illustrations & Portraits

Ghost Writing of Novels and Non-Fiction

Depends on the project. Standard industry pricing of \$60 per hour for ghost writing of novels and non-fiction. Negotiable.

OR

- Flat prices for word count:
- Novellas up to 20,000 words – \$ 5,000
- Novellas up to 40,000 words – \$ 10,000
- Novels and non-fiction up to 60,000 words – \$20,000
- Novels and non-fiction over 100,000 words – \$40,000
- Includes basic editing by a professional editor.
- (1/2 fee paid upon signing work contract and the rest at completion)

ILLUSTRATION: I use standard industry pricing.

Flat prices for commissioned work depend on size on page, style, detail, media, and quantity of illustrations.

- Large \$250 to \$1500 when original art is larger than 9 X 12 in.
- Small \$50 to \$500 illustrations ½ page or less or spot illustrations

Other pricing available depends on if I take a percentage of the royalties from an established author with good sales. This will drop prices below industry standard pricing and is negotiable.

References are available.

PORTRAITS: Dogs, Cats, Horses, Exotics and People too.

Pencil portraits come matted and ready for framing.

Graphite Pencil

- 9 X 12 is \$60
- 11 X 14 is \$75

Colored Pencil

- 9 X 12 is \$100
- 11 X 14 is \$150

Oil/Acrylic

- 9 X 12 is \$250
- Full body pet portrait 16 X 20 is \$500
- 11 X 14 is \$350
- 18 X 24 is \$800
- 16 X 20 is \$450
- 24 X 30 is \$1200

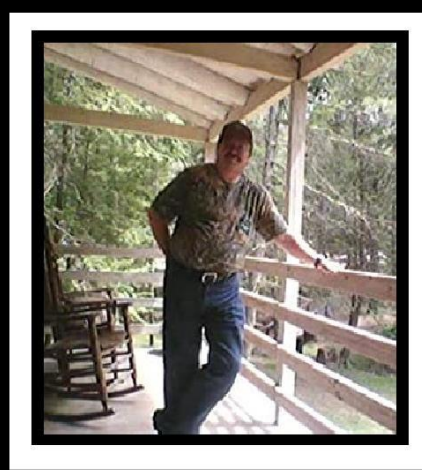
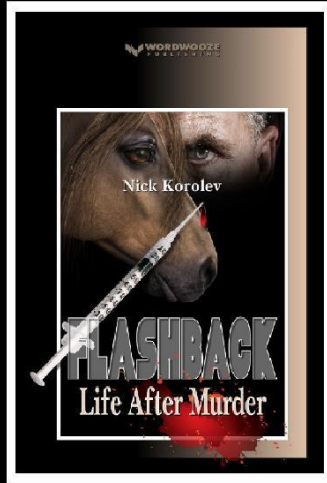
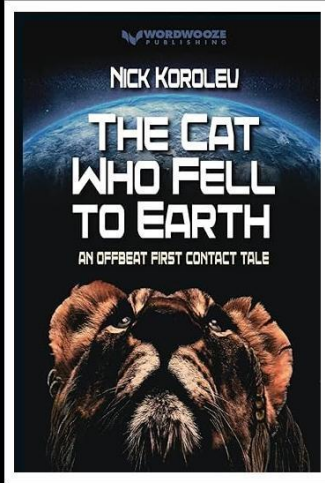
